9. Interpreting Dreams and Visions

This Week's Lesson Summary:

It may not seem very spiritual to take such an effort to figure out the meanings of dreams. We could argue, if God wants us to know the meaning, why doesn't He just come out and say what He means? But God has chosen this method of speaking to His children. Rather than fight it, we should embrace the adventure of seeking out the meanings. It's one of the primary ways He spoke in the Bible, and He is still using them today to engage us into finding out His ways and secrets.
